Bachelor's degree in Health, Education, Social Work, Liberal Arts, or a related field; or equivalent education and/or experience in human services or community based organizations. Professional experience working in human services, delivering educational programs, and specific experience working with MSM preferred. Computer literacy required. Basic knowledge of social networking media and website design desired. Good organizational skills, communication skills, public speaking, and presentation skills are essential.
