The Southern Tier AIDS Program is seeking a **Women's Services Program Coordinator** who will conduct all aspects of program planning and implementation of the HIV/STI Prevention and Related Services for Women grant. This position will plan, coordinate and facilitate all associated groups/events and activities, including one-on-one risk reduction assessment and HIV/HCV/STI education. Using risk assessment, harm reduction, HIV testing, and referrals for related services, delivers a curriculum based prevention education program working toward a reduction of risks for HIV and STI's among women of color.

**Qualifications:**

Bachelor's degree in Health, Education, Social Work, Liberal Arts, or a related field preferred or equivalent education and experience in human services or community based organization. Professional experience working in human services; experience implementing and delivering curriculum based education programs necessary. Prior experience facilitating groups and delivering HIV prevention programs preferred; knowledge of community resources; comfortable with and experience working with communities of color and women required, prior case management experience preferred. Ability to work with individuals on behavior change from perspectives other than abstinence only. Computer literacy and strong verbal communication skills are required; planning, organizing and program facilitation, public speaking and presentation skills are essential. Supervision and time management required.
