Trends...

- ❑ STAP's client caseload is the highest in its history. 40 STAP clients are also co-infected with Hepatitis C.
- ❑ Despite a decrease in the rate of deaths from AIDS in the U.S., new infections continue at a rate of 56,300 per year.
- ❑ In the United States, 1 in 4 young women between the ages of 19 and 25, were infected with an STD.
- ❑ STD rates for syphilis are on the rise in our area.
